Rebuilding Together Montgomery County (RTMC) has a variety of programs that operate year-round and are managed through the efforts of 5 full-time staff, 2 part-time staff, and 3 AmeriCorps members. Our programs include our Handyman Program (small scale repairs), Critical Needs Program (emergency services), LINKS Program (referrals), and an Energy Efficiency Program, all of which operate throughout the year.
